These smart salting workshops explore a variety of best practices for managing snow and ice on paved surfaces. Through presentations and class exercises, participants will learn how to integrate science with practical winter maintenance while minimizing impacts on the environment.

Topics include: material selection and application rates, weather conditions, material storage, de-icing & anti-icing, new maintenance methods, and environmental effects.

Participants have the option to complete an exam to receive the MPCA Level 1 Snow and Ice Control Best Practices Certification.
